Usage

Parameters

Mandatory

name

The name of the template appears centred in the top row of the table.

*list_{*n*}*

(i.e. *list1*, *list2*, etc.) The body of the template, usually a list of links. Format is inline, although the text can be entered on separate lines if the entire list is enclosed within `<div>` `</div>`. At least one *list* parameter is required. Each *list_{*n*}* may be preceded by a corresponding *group_{*n*}* parameter, if provided (see below). There is a limit of 10 lists/groups in a template.

Optional

group_n
 (i.e. *group1*, *group2*, etc.) If specified, text appears in a header displayed above *list_n*.
 first param
 inline CSS for the table
